#### **Director's Notes:**

Another year has flown by at the airport as we approach the Christmas holidays. We survived an April 3, 2008 tornado at the airport and bounced back quickly with a concerted cleanup effort by city agencies and tenants at the airport.

The airport has taken on a different appearance with the removal of 77 acres of trees on the north side of the airport this year. Over 5,000 vehicles a day travel Maryland Avenue and the tree removal has open the airport to the public traveling on Maryland.

#### **VEHICLES ON TAXIWAYS AND RUNWAYS**

According to the NLR Airport Commission Rules and Regulations, only service vehicles are permitted on the airport taxiways and runways except for loading, unloading, and servicing of aircraft or hangars.

In addition bicycles and pedestrians are not permitted on runways. Bicycles and pedestrians are permitted on taxiways and ramps only for the purpose of accessing aircraft or hangars.

The private vehicles travelling Charlie taxiway (runway 17/35 parallel taxiway) to and from the further north hangars from the west ramp are not permitted on the taxiway. Please use the north gate to access the north hangars.
