**A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING \$4,000.00 FROM ACT 833 FUNDS FOR A USED 2.5 TON BRUSH TRUCK FOR THE NORTH LITTLE ROCK FIRE DEPARTMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the North Little Rock Fire Department ("NLRFD") needs to replace an existing 1961 2.5 ton brush truck that is no longer operable; and

WHEREAS, the Arkansas Forestry Commission in Greenbrier ("Forestry Commission") has a 1980's model military 2.5 ton truck that was completely refurbished in 1999 and has offered it to the NLRFD with the requirement that it be painted red and in service within 60 days of receipt thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Forestry Commission will provide required servicing of the truck at an estimated cost of \$600.00, and painting will cost approximately \$3,000.00±, or a total estimated cost of up to \$4,000.00; and

WHEREAS, there is a sufficient amount available in Act 833 Funds to cover the costs of servicing and painting the truck.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the amount of up to Four Thousand & 00/100 Dollars (\$4,000.00) is hereby appropriated from Act 833 Funds for servicing and painting a 1980's model military 2.5 ton truck from the Arkansas Forestry Commission in Greenbrier to be used by the North Little Rock Fire Department as a brush truck (see Exhibit "A" attached hereto).

SECTION 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.





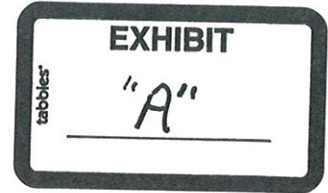

Mayor Hays:

I am requesting that you sponsor legislation for a 1980's model (completely refurbished in 1999) military 2.5 ton truck to use as a brush truck; this will replace an existing 1961 2.5 ton brush truck (never refurbished) that is no longer operable. The truck will be coming from the Arkansas Forestry Commission in Greenbrier.

The truck will be completely serviced by the Forestry Commission prior to us taking possession. However, we must have it painted red and in service within 60 days of receipt. The approximate price of the truck will be \$400-\$600 depending on the cost of required servicing, and the cost of painting will be \$2500-\$3000 (this price is a sight unseen quote) our knowledgeable mechanic, Tom stated the price to get the Brush Truck in service shall not be more than \$4000.

The amount of \$4,000 should be appropriated from Act 833 Funds.
