ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A HILLSIDE CUT TO REMOVE MATERIALS ON PROPERTY LOCATED ALONG MACARTHUR DRIVE IN THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, application has been duly made by Grant Garrett of Grant Garrett Excavation, Inc., 12913 I-30, Benton, Arkansas 72015, seeking approval for a hillside cut to remove materials on property located along MacArthur Drive immediately north and adjacent to the North Little Rock Fire Station at 6550 MacArthur Drive in the City of North Little Rock (see maps attached collectively hereto as Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS, the request has not been reviewed by the Planning Commission, and the applicant is seeking approval from the North Little Rock City Council; and

WHEREAS, a legal advertisement of notice of a public hearing to be held January 28, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. has been placed in the newspaper; and

WHEREAS, North Little Rock engineering staff have reviewed the site plan and hillside cut proposal and believe the hillside cut will be stable and will do no harm to abutting properties (see Exhibit B attached hereto).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That a hillside cut for property located on the along MacArthur Drive immediately north and adjacent to the North Little Rock Fire Station at 6550 MacArthur Drive in the City of North Little Rock, as shown on the site plan attached hereto as Exhibit C, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2: All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 3: That the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any section, phrase or provision shall be declared or held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remainder of the sections, phrases or provisions.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined by the City Council that hillside cuts pose particular risk to neighboring properties such that proper regulations are immediately necessary to ensure the lateral support of structures and the orderly development of the City, and accordingly, the public health, safety and welfare; THEREFORE, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.


