

# ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING JOB CLASSIFICATIONS AND NUMBERS OF EMPLOYEES FOR EACH DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK FOR 2019; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Council is responsible for establishing the number of employees in each department; and

WHEREAS, by enacting an ordinance listing the numbers of employees in each job classification in each department for 2019, the City Council will be in a better position to monitor and evaluate the numbers of employees necessary to the operation of each city department.
