The regular meeting of the North Little Rock City Council scheduled for Monday, July 27, 2015, was called to order at 6:01 p.m. by the honorable Mayor Joe A. Smith.

The roll having been called and the following Aldermen answered to their names: DEBI ROSS, BETH WHITE, MAURICE TAYLOR, LINDA ROBINSON, STEVE BAXTER, and BRUCE FOUTCH (6/0). Aldermen CHARLIE HIGHT and MURRY WITCHER were absent. City Clerk Diane Whitbey and Assistant City Attorney Daniel McFadden were also present.

The prayer and pledge of allegiance were led by Mayor Smith. Mayor Smith recited the opening prayer from a recent U. S. Senate session presented by Reverend Ken Carney, 1st Church of the Nazarene, Hot Springs, Arkansas. Reverend Carney is the husband of Hot Springs, Mayor Ruth Carney.

On the motion of Alderman Taylor and seconded by Alderman Baxter, and by consent of all members present, the minutes from the North Little Rock City Council meeting and Special Call meeting held on Monday, July 13, 2015, were approved, accepted and filed as prepared by the City Clerk (6/0).

Mayor Smith asked Mrs. Margaret Powell, Director of External Affairs to come forward. Mrs. Powell said a delegation from North Little Rock's Sister City, Uiwang City, South Korea were present. This year marks the 15th Year of the exchange program. Mrs. Powell thanked the council for their funding and support of the program. She then introduced Mr. Hong and Un Suk Yin who were chaperones. Mrs. Powell introduced the host families who were present. She also introduced her summer intern Christopher Leer who has been a big help in preparing for the delegation visit. Mr. Hong then read a letter to Mayor Smith from the Mayor of Uiwang City. Mayor Smith thanked Mr. Hong and thanked all of the host families and Mrs. Powell for their time and efforts. He then asked the visiting youth to stand and be welcomed.

Mayor Smith announced public comment on legislation. Mrs. Judy Cromwell spoke in support of R-15-108. She and her husband have been maintaining the property which has a lot of pretty flowers and other foliage on it. There being no one else signed in to speak, public comment was concluded.

On the motion of Alderman Taylor and seconded by Alderwoman Ross, and all members present having voted "aye", consent items R-15-104, R-15-105, and R-15-107 were adopted (6/0).

R-15-104 (RESOLUTION NO. 8831 – MAYOR SMITH)

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF MARIE-BERNARD MILLER TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CENTRAL ARKANSAS WATER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES, was adopted (6/0).

R-15-105 (RESOLUTION NO. 8832 – MAYOR SMITH)

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR RENOVATIONS TO PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE FACILITIES AT 2800 WILLOW STREET; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES, was adopted (6/0).

R-15-107 (RESOLUTION NO. 8833 – MAYOR SMITH)

A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN CITY-OWNED VEHICLES, OUTDATED PARTS, AND OTHER EQUIPMENT AS SURPLUS; PROVIDING FOR AUCTION THEREOF; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES, was adopted (6/0).

NEW BUSINESS

R-15-106 (RESOLUTION NO. 8834 – MAYOR SMITH)

A RESOLUTION APPROVING ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT AWARDED TO THE NORTH LITTLE ROCK FIRE DEPARTMENT BY FEMA UNDER ITS STAFFING FOR ADEQUATE FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE (SAFER) PROGRAM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES, was read.

A motion to adopt was made by Alderman Taylor and seconded by Alderwoman Ross. Alderwoman Ross asked Fire Chief James Murphy to come forward. Chief Murphy said this grant (\$2,632,824.00) does not require any matching funds. These funds will allow the city's fire department to come closer to meeting Federal Standard Guidelines on minimal manpower on equipment. New Firefighters will be equipped using Act 833 Funds. Mayor Smith said applicants understand that these positions are being funded by a grant and may not be available after the Federal Funding runs out. Chief Murphy also thanked Human Resources Director Betty Anderson and her staff for their assistance. Mayor Smith said as of today, there are 83 applicants. Ms. Anderson said the deadline to submit an application is Friday, July 31, 2015. Alderman Foutch asked if the city would be setting up for mass applications at any other locations. Ms. Anderson said they were at McCain Mall Saturday where 31 applications were collected. Radio advertising will run Wednesday through Friday. On the previous motion, and by consent of all members present, the resolution was adopted (6/0).

R-15-108 (RESOLUTION NO. 8835 – ALDERMEN ROSS AND WHITE)

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY LOCATED AT 903 WEST 45TH STREET IN THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK FROM THE COMMISSIONER OF STATE LANDS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES, was read. A motion to

adopt was made by Alderwoman Ross and seconded by Alderwoman White. Alderwoman Ross said this property belonged to Ms. Betty Nash. Ms. Nash was active in the community before she passed away. Ms. Nash was also a member of the Iris Society and planted lots of plants on the property. This property went to the State Land Commission for back taxes, but did not sale at public auction. Alderwoman Ross suggested turning the property into a pocket Flower Park. Mrs. Cromwell said they do not want city crews caring for the property. They will continue to maintain it. Mrs. Cromwell did say there is a dead tree on the corner at 45th and Marion. She is concerned that it may fall. Mayor

Smith asked someone to check on it. On the previous motion, and by consent of all members present, the resolution was adopted (6/0).

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A SPECIAL USE TO ALLOW A THERAPEUTIC MASSAGE CLINIC IN A C-1 ZONE FOR CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY LOCATED AT 2525 WILLOW #1 IN THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES, was read. On the motion of Alderman Taylor and seconded by Alderman Foutch, and by consent of all members present, the rules were suspended and the ordinance was placed on its second reading (6/0). On the motion of Alderman Taylor and seconded by Alderman Baxter,

and by consent of all members present, the rules were again suspended and the ordinance was placed on its third and final reading (6/0). Alderwoman Ross agreed the residents of Military Heights do not want any more Special Uses. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3.1 (REGULATIONS APPLYING TO ALL DISTRICTS) AND ARTICLE 21 (TABLE OF PERMITTED USES) OF ORDINANCE NO. 7697 (THE ZONING ORDINANCE) REGARDING FARMING AND THE KEEPING OF LIVESTOCK; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES; was read. The legislation was then held at the request of the sponsor, Alderman Taylor.
