A RESOLUTION TO MAKE MINOR AMENDMENTS TO THE 2019 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK IN REGARDS TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2019, the City of North Little Rock, Arkansas (the "City"), adopted Resolution No. 9689, approving the 2019 Annual Action Plan for the City of North Little Rock; and

WHEREAS, the City submitted the 2019 Annual Action Plan to the Department of Housing and Urban Development on June 11, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the 2019 Annual Action Plan contains the 2019 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Projects and Budgets; and

WHEREAS, from time to time it is necessary to make minor budget adjustments on Community Development projects with excess funds and projects in need of additional funding; and

WHEREAS, the City is making a minor amendment to its 2019 Annual Action Plan to reallocate \$6,000.00 from the Administration-CDBG project to the NLR Boys and Girls Club Great Futures Program project for the provision of after-school care provided to at-risk youth in North Little Rock; and

WHEREAS, the City is making a minor amendment to its 2019 Annual Action Plan to reallocate \$6,000.00 from the Administration-CDBG project to the CareLink Meals on Wheels Program project for the provision of home-delivered meals to needy elderly citizens in North Little Rock; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the 2019 Annual Action Plan is amended pursuant to Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2: That \$6,000.00 from the Administration-CDBG Project will be reallocated to the NLR Boys and Girls Club Great Futures Program project as outlined in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

SECTION 3: That \$6,000.00 from the Administration-CDBG Project will be reallocated to the CareLink Meals on Wheels Program project as outlined in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

SECTION 4: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
